Best Time To Visit

Spring - The quarry gardens will
be starting the grow, with greenery and
spring bulbs including daffodils, tulips
and hellebores

Summer - See an explosion of colour
from the flowering rhododendrons, best
viewed from the terrace gardens. In the
quarry garden, explore exotic plants
including the huge umbrella-like
Gunnera leaves.

Autumn - Spectacular colours around
the site as the trees turn

Winter - Look out for late flowering
pinkish red Rhododendrons, snowdrops
and conifers
